Introduction

Forthbank Recycling Centre has been provided to allow you to recycle or dispose of household waste and some types of commercial waste.

This guide provides information on what materials can be recycled at the Centre together with guidelines to help you make best use of the site.

Household waste

Household waste including bulky items and garden waste can be recycled or disposed of at the Recycling Centre free of charge. A range of facilities in the form of skips, bays and points exist to maximise the amount of waste that is recycled.

Commercial waste

A limited range of commercial waste is also accepted at the Recycling Centre. Waste from clubs, government departments, hotels, markets, offices, showrooms, shops and societies are classified as commercial waste.

All commercial waste is subject to disposal charges (See page 13).

Summer

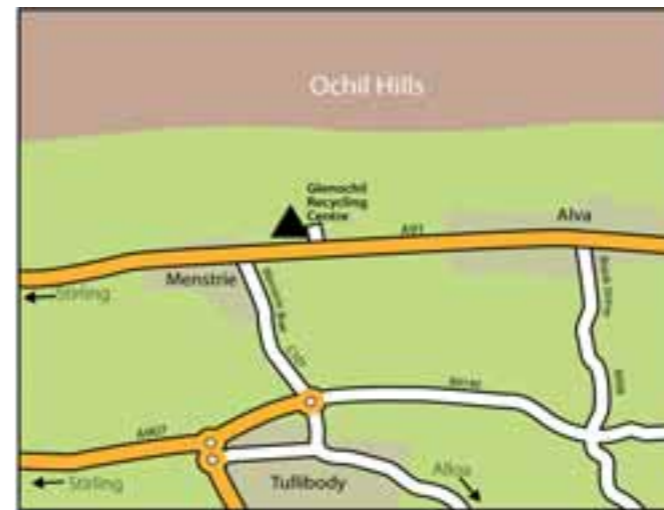
1st April to 30th September 8.00am - 8.00pm (last admission 15 minutes before closing)

- Before visiting the Centre with your waste, please take time to separate your waste into different material types. This will make it quicker and easier for you to use the Centre.
 - Stop at the gate and tell the attendants what you are recycling or disposing of and they will direct you to the correct bays.

Commercial waste disposal charges

All commercial waste is subject to disposal charges. Entry to the site is by pre-paid voucher. Vouchers can be purchased from the council offices at Greenfield House, Tullibody Road, Alloa, FK10 2AD or call the helpline free on 0500 545 540.

A maximum vehicle size of 3.5 tonnes GVW is permitted. One voucher per visit.

We cannot accept industrial or hazardous material from commercial sources including; asbestos, batteries, electrical equipment, fluorescent tubes, fridges or motor oil.

Materials Not Accepted



The following types of business waste are not accepted:

- General builders' waste.
- Hazardous commercial waste.
- Industrial waste from construction, demolition, excavation, alteration or repair work.
- Waste from workshops and vehicle maintenance premises.

Dumping waste is illegal. If you do it you are committing a serious offence and may be prosecuted.

If you employ a contractor for work on your home, make sure they provide details of where the waste goes - or you might find that you could be held responsible if it is illegally dumped.

If you see anyone dumping rubbish illegally then call the Dumb Dumpers Stop Line on **0845 2 30 40 90**.

The call will be answered by a specially arranged call centre where the staff will assess the nature of the call. If the incident is ongoing or is believed to be of a hazardous nature, or in a water course, it will be passed to the Police and Scottish Environment Protection Agency respectively.

If the incident is not urgent or is of a non-hazardous nature the information will be passed to the Local Authority for investigation.
